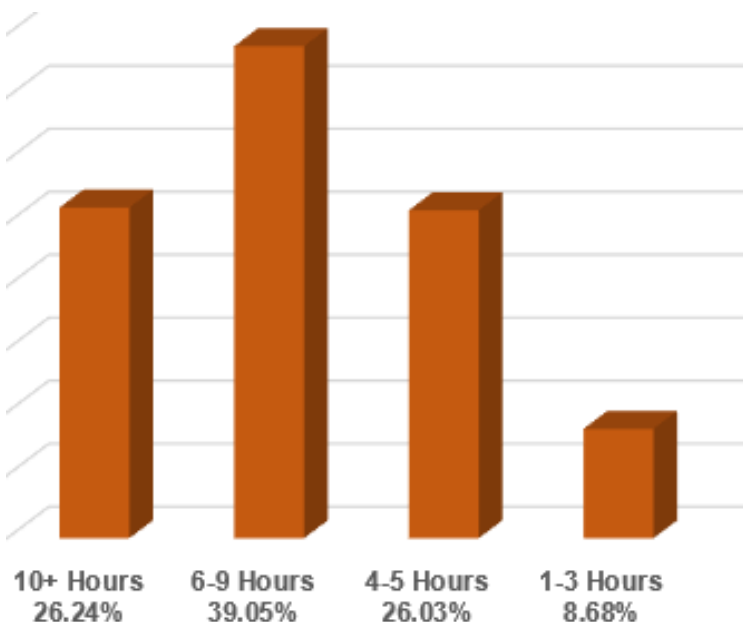

Once again, **95%** of attendees rated their overall Austin NECA Show experience Excellent or Very Good.

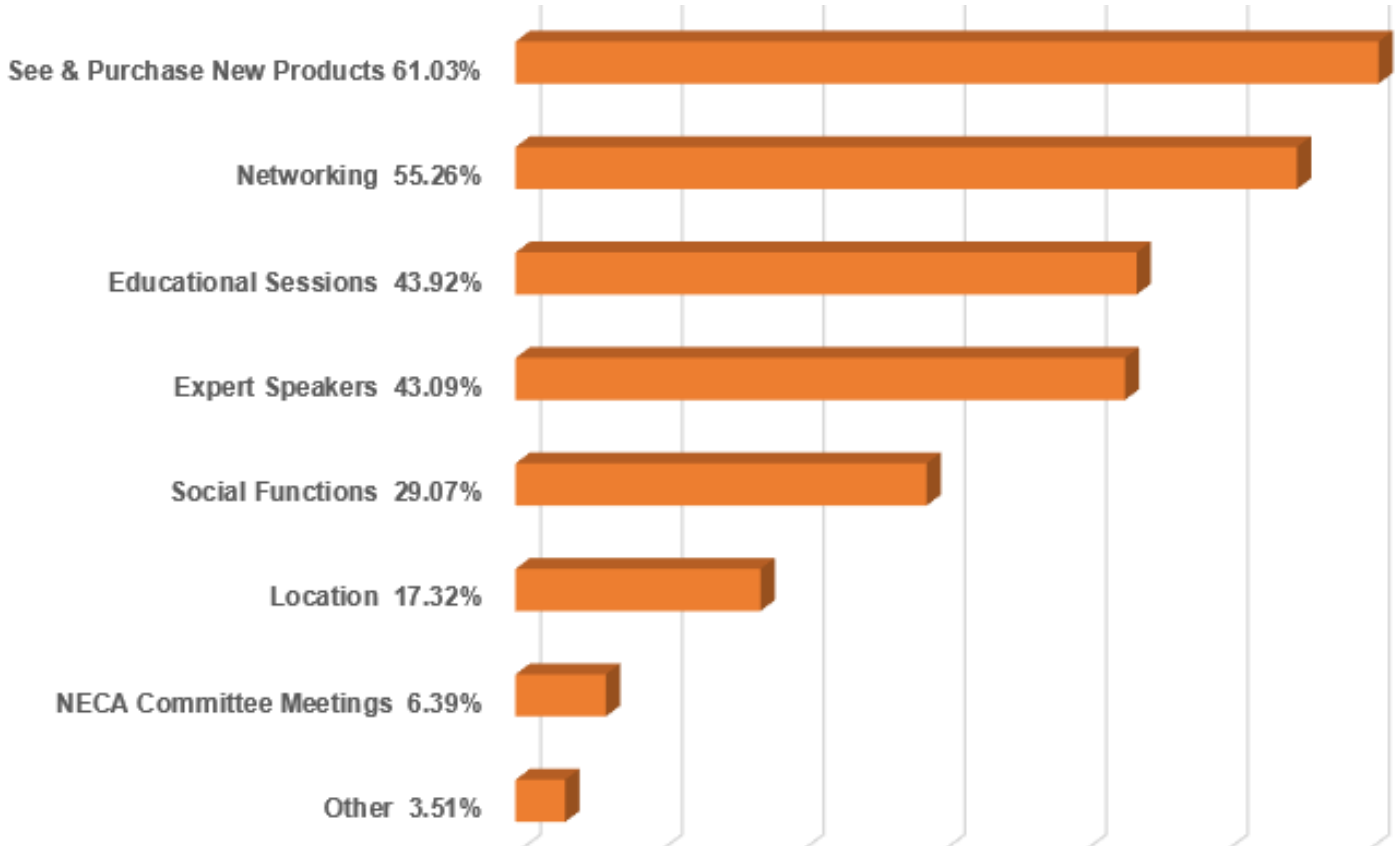
33% of contractors attended the NECA Show for the first time.

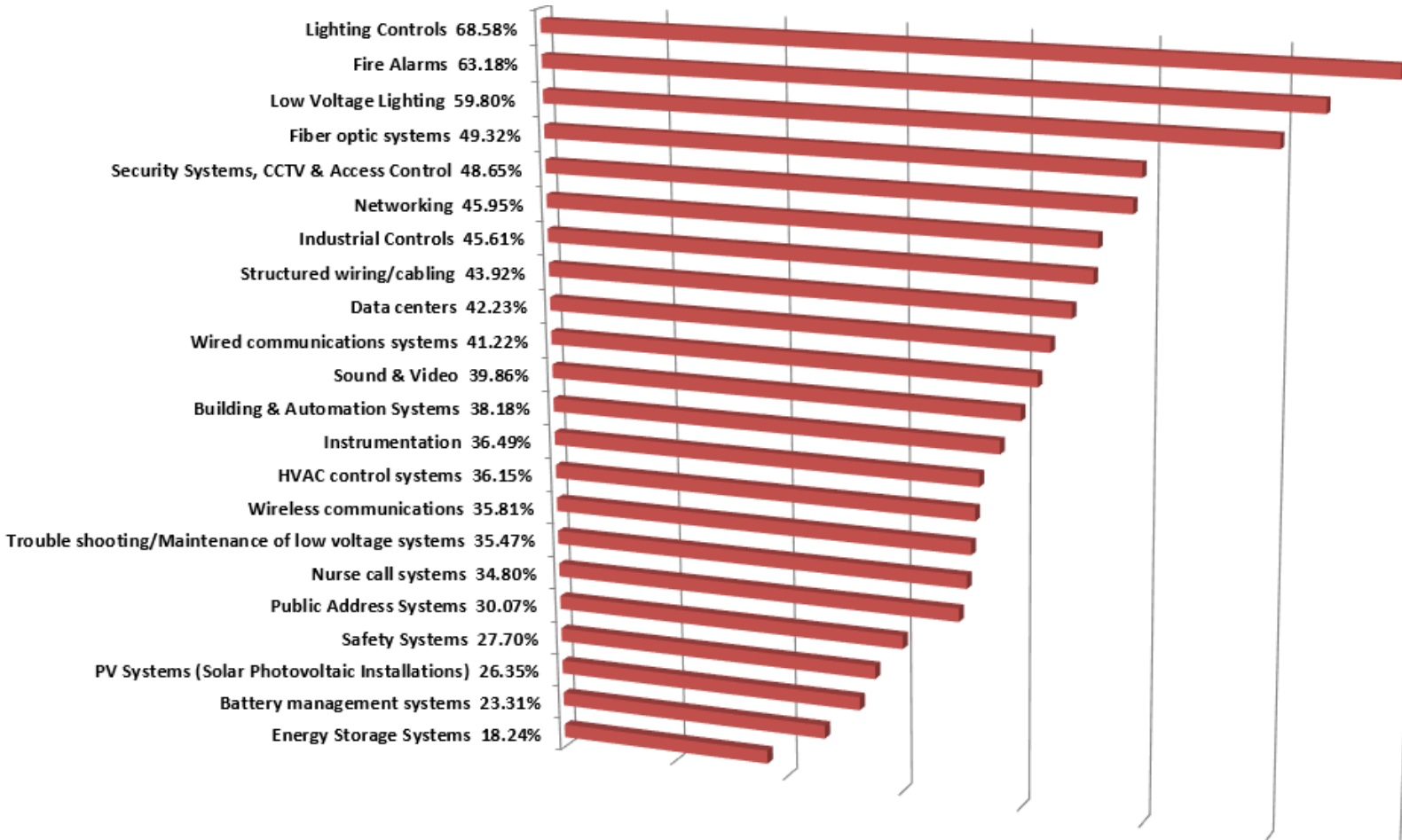

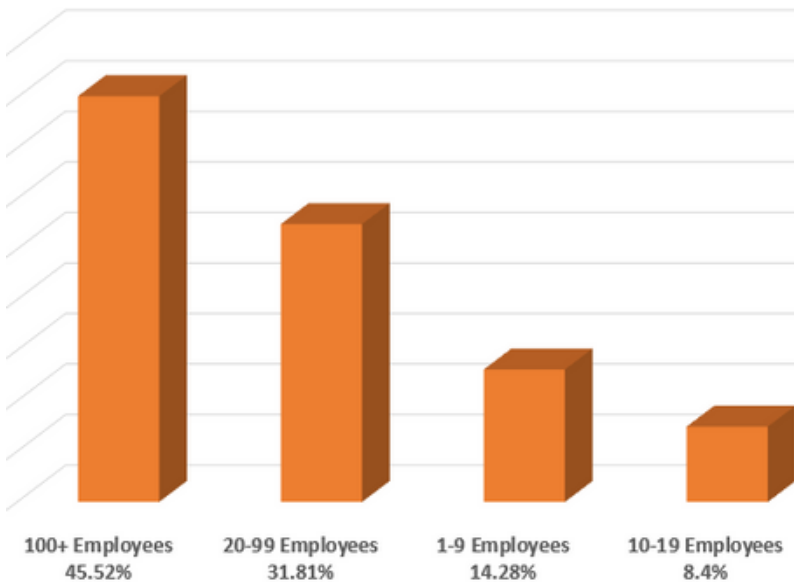

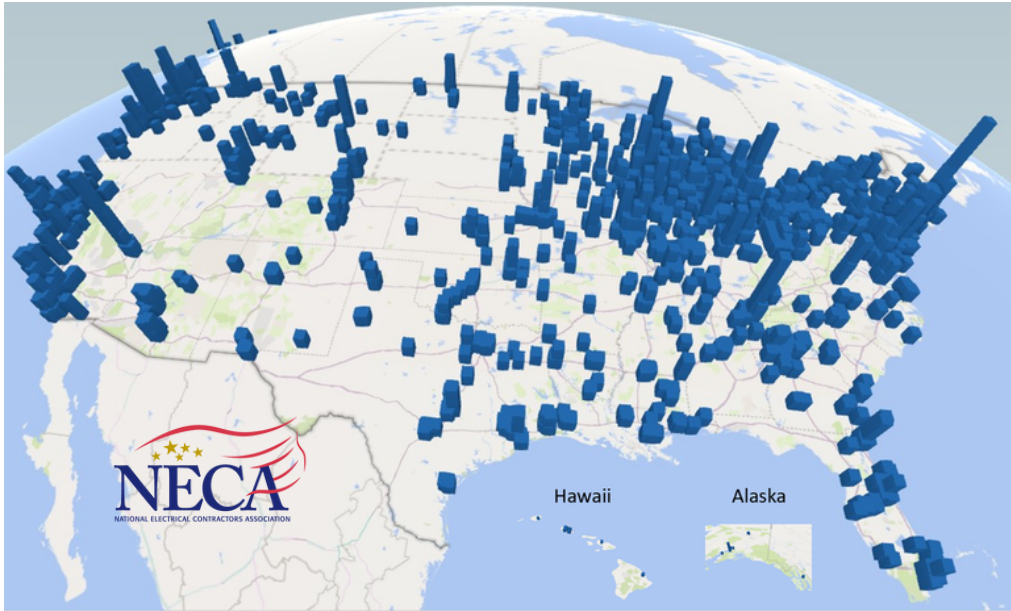
